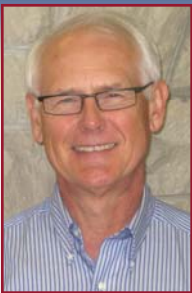

FROM THE PASTOR

Going Forward



On Sunday morning, July 17th, I led worship services in a congregation on the great plains with flat land, a few miles from the South Dakota border, in a town surrounded by miles and miles of corn. That night I carried my stuff up the apartment stairs in Madison, surrounded by lakes, hills and trees, walking in Bethel's office that following morning. 400 miles of distance between only underscores the many differences between Madison and Marshall. Even so, I am most struck by what is common to both congregations. I said "goodbye" to some exceedingly warm and friendly brothers and sisters in Christ only to be welcomed hours later by other exceedingly warm and friendly brothers and sisters in Christ.

When a congregation experiences major changes, something most graphic when its pastoral leaders move on, there is inevitably a measure of discomfort. This is understandable. But upon deeper reflection, healthy congregations like Bethel and St. Stephen quickly realize that what matters most has not really changed at all. Jesus still is the head and the gospel the same. His continuing presence with us always continues to shape and link his people, even over time and space. Mission itself is unchanged and the cherished contributions of pastors and laity alike knit that invisible fabric we call "culture". Our future will not be a product of programs, building projects and resources as much as who we have been shaped to be and what we value as God's people.

Both St. Stephen and Bethel are undergoing pastoral searches because long-time senior pastors, who knew everyone's name, have left. And yet, if I quoted the wise veterans of each congregation who expressed what I just shared above, you probably couldn't tell which congregation they came from. For while we have unique differences and always will, it's actually quite inspiring for me to witness the expressions of faith and insight that come from the laity. My tenure as Interim Senior Pastor here is not typical. I expect I'll be here through October, unless there are unforeseen delays in a senior pastor's arrival date. That does not give time to do much of what interim work usually does. However, two things are perhaps important for you to know.

Even before I arrived, the staff had already articulated what I independently purposed for these next few months. That is, our goal was for Bethel's ministry to

move forward into the fall at full throttle. We've made a few adjustments and I believe that is exactly what will happen. Bethel has so many fine lay leaders and staff.

Second, I'll be leading a fall Bible study in September-October on Thursday evenings. It's focus will include opportunities to relate the key ideas to Bethel's mission. I see this study as an opportunity for the congregation to begin preparing for its new ministry chapter.

My wife Normajean and I look forward to being with you. Thank you most sincerely for the warm welcome we have received. I echo what Bishop Barrow said in his sermon, July 31. When one looks at what is working well at Bethel, there is so much for which to be grateful and excited. These gifts form a rich foundation on which the Spirit will work through Bethel going forward.

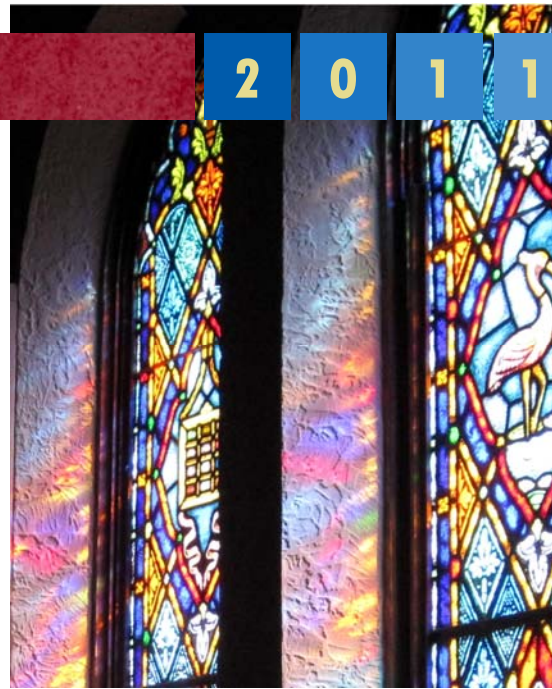
