

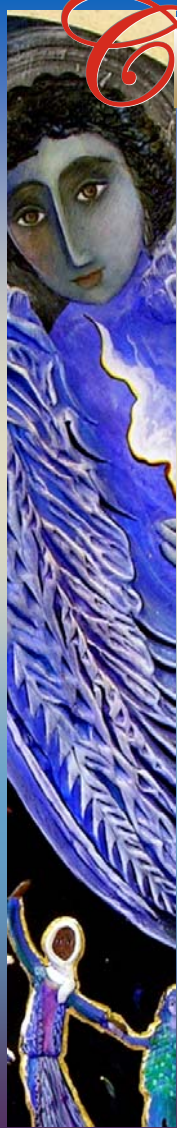

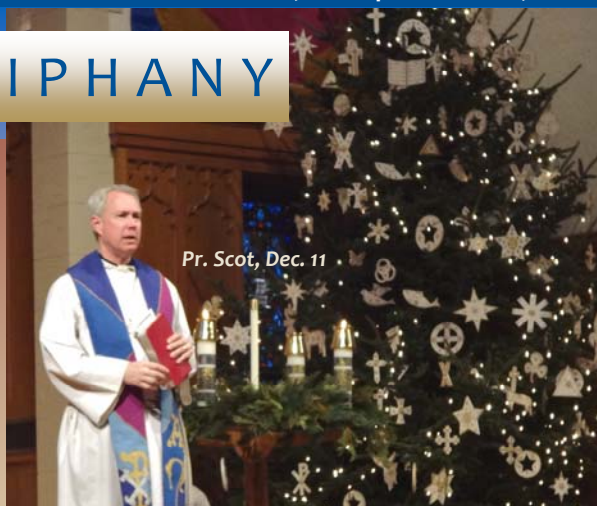

## FROM THE PASTOR

In the coming week, you'll be told that the birth of Christ Jesus, Son of God, has happened. You'll be told that this child is salvation. What's your reaction to receiving this gift from God going to be?

Will you go on believing as you always have, telling yourself that this is a celebration we have every year for something that happened on one night 2000 years ago, or will the birth of God as human give a jolt to your faith?

As we go through our lives as Christians, we talk a lot about the grace of God, we talk a lot about forgiveness, about God being with us through crises, about serving our neighbor. But how much do we talk about who *Jesus*, the *Son of God*, the resurrected-from-the-dead, tangible, in-your-face, power of the *universe*, is, and what he does? And not only in the "Jesus is the reason for the season" way, but in the "this God-man is the whole reason for our existence and has transformed our lives as we know it" way?

Probably not much. We tend to believe in actions, not words.

I don't think it's because we don't believe in Jesus or don't want him to be a part of faith, but we've taken his birth, life, death, and resurrection as part of the assumed basics of faith for so long, that sometimes we gloss over the mention of his name. Which makes it hard for some of us to remember *why* it is that we believe there is a God who loves, forgives, and saves. And it's a pretty important "why," by the way.

But this season, the birth of Jesus is here to remind us of who this God really is and what lengths this God will go to in order to love us. Do you know what's said about this child being born? "He is named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6b); "he will establish and uphold [his kingdom] with justice and with righteousness" (Isaiah 9:7b); and that he is "destined... to be a sign that will be opposed so that the inner thoughts of many will be revealed" (Luke 2:34-35). That's some big stuff.



### Where have you seen Jesus?

This year, we have the chance to end the year and start the year with worship (New Year's Day falls on a Sunday!). As Jesus is born and we receive God in the new year, where will you be brought in your faith? How will this God transform you?

For Simeon in our text this week, he held Jesus in his arms and proclaimed, "Lord, now you are dismissing your servant in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for glory to your people Israel" (Luke 2:29-32). By just holding Jesus, he was immediately led to bless others, to proclaim what sort of gift Jesus was to the world, and to live out the rest of his days in the midst of fulfilled promises.

You? What will encountering Jesus do to your life of faith?

## Hope House Mothers and Babies Share Appreciation

While Advent is a time of reflection about the Holy Child, it is also a time of reflection and thanksgiving from the young homeless mothers and their children Bethel supports at Hope House. Jennifer wrote: "Thank you for allowing me to have the privilege to live in your beautiful home. ...I am grateful for the support and encouragement that was given by all staff and volunteers..."

Janisha sent a thank-you: "I was able to have a place to stay when me and my son and my unborn child had nowhere to go. It felt comfortable and reliable and safe. It made things possible that were not possible before. The Hope House gave hope that as long as I think positive and put in the effort, good things will happen. I am very thankful that Hope House welcomed me and my kids with open arms and changed our lives for the better. After leaving Hope House I was able to move into my own apartment, something I didn't think could happen, but it did!"

Hope House opened in 2002 and has served over 150 mothers and children. A program coordinator and volunteers assist in making arrangements for permanent housing, with resume development and job searches, setting and achieving educational objectives, assessing needs, learning good parenting skills and establishing goals.

Bethel members purchased the house and continue to support the program with dollars, volunteers and furnishings when a family has found permanent housing. Thank you Bethel members for helping. Thank you God for giving us the opportunity to serve.
