Bethel Reaches Out to the Homebound

Bringing Bethel To You

The **Personal Connection** with our homebound members and friends is maintained through many areas at Bethel: TV ministry, website, mailings of the *Bethelite* and other print publications, and the personal efforts of our Pastoral Care Ministry. Lois Seymour, Pastoral Care Associate, schedules routine and repeating home and institutional visits with our homebound members, usually 25 visits each month. Visits are shared by Lois, and the Bethel Pastors.

During each visit, people may choose to receive Communion. These visits are available to anyone who has been unable to attend Bethel for several weeks. Please call Lois to schedule a visit: 608-222-9037, for yourself, or a loved one. Visits may also be scheduled by calling the Bethel Office, 608-257-3577.

Bethel's TV Ministry began in 1981. Today, this weekly telecast reaches an average of 30,000 viewers through 7 stations, covering all of Wisconsin, eastern Iowa and northwest Illinois.

For the last two years, Bethel's TV Ministry has been fully funded by contributions outside of the Operating Budget. Over half of the \$180,000 received annually is from non-members. Bethel continues to make substantial investments in equipment and facilities, including on-demand website streaming, to meet the needs of this expanding ministry for our many homebound and out-of-area worshippers. For those able to attend church, Bethel offers a variety of Worship services at five times during each weekend.



FROM THE PASTOR

Last summer, smarter people than me suggested that I begin to use a laptop so that I could have all my information in one computer, rather than two. Let her tell it: "The move from Wisconsin to Tennessee was so traumatic for me that it affected my health and mental state very badly. What makes me happy is watching 'my' church and the Brewers. I can't tell you enough times how happy I am that I get Bethel services every week on the computer (and I can watch several others from previous weeks if I so desire)."

Don't you just love technology?!

(I'm sure you know that all of our TV programs are available through our website via something called "streaming." You just click and watch.) Our Tennessee friend writes that her brother also watches in Florida. Don't you just love technology?

Now, if I can just find those addresses that got swallowed and that letter that somehow can't be found. How about two cheers for technology!?
