## FROM THE PASTOR

**Active Latino Lay Leadership in Training.** In 2009, a couple of my Latino parishioners asked if they could go deeper into theology with me. They were very grateful for what they received during worship and in the prayer circles, but wanted more. That moved me to plan some courses on theology and discipleship as part of a Latino Lay Leadership Training. When I introduced it to the congregation, I was pleased to see that a group of around 20 were interested. So, we began in the fall of 2009 with an introduction to the Bible, Old and New Testaments, once a month. They showed great interest and asked if we could double it to twice a month, so we did. I had to create a web page to keep them informed and to share documents, bibliography, homework and links. Later we began webcasting it live for some who couldn't be present and posting the recordings on the

web page. Soon, we had students from our Beloit mission. The word spread and Latino parishioners from the Milwaukee area, Illinois and Minnesota were interested. This educational program became not only a Bethel Latino Lay Training, but Synodical and regional, as well. In addition to the Old and New Testaments, we have studied together Evangelism, Preaching, Lutheran Liturgy, and Church History. Other subjects to be presented are Youth Leadership, Stewardship, Bible Study techniques, Comparative Religion, and more. We are in the process of bringing this effort to the level of a Latino Lay School. Resulting from a year of training, we have one Lay Minister, Einstein Gonzalez, working at our mission in Beloit, San Jose, and we hope to place a couple more in the development of new Latino Ministries within our Synod.

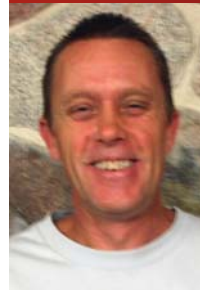

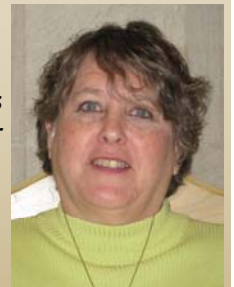
## Welcome Tim Bloom
