## FROM THE PASTOR



### Mystery

This week in Bible Study, I asked our group whether they believed that angels were still at work in the world. There were about 30 people in our group. Quickly, most of the men and women in our group raised their hands indicating that yes, they did believe that angels were out there helping us out. I was surprised at how many people responded.

One lady told us of a time when she was caught in a huge traffic jam on a congested interstate, her car was overheating as were many cars. There weren't any neighborhoods in sight. Two teenage boys suddenly appeared with a jug of water, in the middle of the interstate, and offered to give her some water for her car. She thanked them and just as quickly they disappeared, vanishing. She was sure those two boys were angels.

Another gentleman told us of a time when he was in the hospital after painful back surgery. The nurses struggled just to get him out of bed. He knew he

had to walk but the pain was overwhelming. The nurses told him to focus on a picture down the hallway. Suddenly he saw Jesus beckoning him forward and he was able to walk down the hallway and then back to his bed. That was thirty years ago.

The book of Hebrews instructs us that faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. Occasionally though, the veil is lifted and we are given a glimpse into the mysteries of our faith. We realize that the Jesus we pray to is real, that the angels spoken of in the Bible still intervene on our behalf; that visions are still given. I am grateful for our member's willingness to share these stories and others so that our spirits can be open to mystery. During this season of Lenten reflection, "may we all hold fast to the mystery of the faith."

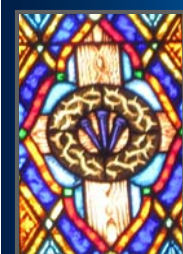
