TUESDAY 6/18/19

Read Ecclesiastes 3:1-8. Go for a walk. Think back over the different roads you have traveled. What were the major turns along the way? How would you describe the road you're on now? While walking, talk to Jesus aloud or in your mind asking him to show you what he wants you to see on your current path.

WEDNESDAY 6/19/19

Read Revelation 21:1-5. Walk through some grass with bare feet. Sit down. Run your toes through the green blades. Draw deep breaths. Take your time. Where do you yearn for something new and good? Embrace in your heart God's promise to you that God is making things new even when you cannot see it. Say it to yourself.

THURSDAY 6/20/19




FRIDAY 6/21/19
