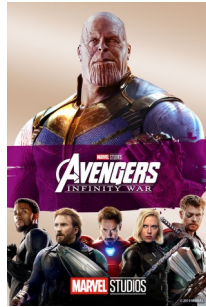




Pt. 1 Avengers: From Victimhood to Victory
